Education Committee Terms of Reference

Purpose

The mandate of this Committee is to be a forum for Ontario Council members involved with advocacy issues related to Education, in Ontario. This committee is responsible for the development and communication of CFUW OC Education related policies on behalf of the Board. Committee projects/initiatives are expected to be aligned with the biennium theme approved by the OC Board.

Activities

- 1. The committee acts as a forum for discussion concerning advocacy on behalf of CFUW Ontario Council. Together with the Advocacy, Legislation and Status of Women and Human Rights committees, they will assist with tracking current and emerging advocacy issues.
- They will exchange information concerning advocacy activities and concerns, with the aim of informing multiple levels – clubs, regions and the Board. The committee will represent CFUW OC on advocacy related matters when requested.
- 3. The committee is expected to produce a year-end report on advocacy activities, for the Ontario Council Annual Report for members.
- 4. Together with the Education, Legislation and Status of Women and Human Rights committees, the advocacy committee develops and maintains administrative procedure for advocacy related communication or activities for Ontario Council. They will be reviewed annually.

Membership

- Committee Chair Board Education Chair
- Board Standing Committee Chairs for Advocacy, Status of Women and Legislation
- CFUW OC President
- Policy advisors approved by the Board
- At least two and not more than six other CFUW members

Meetings

The committee will meet a minimum of 3 times per year or when needed.
