Autumn Peltier

Since the age of 8, Autumn Peltier has been advocating on behalf of water. Now 14, she has been named the chief water commissioner by the Anishinabek Nation. It is a political advocacy group for 40 First Nations across Ontario.

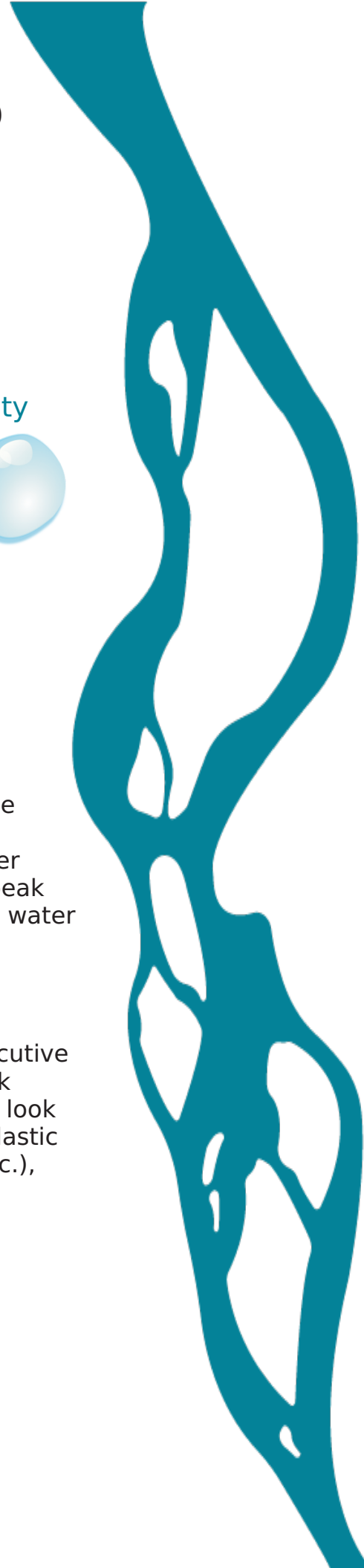
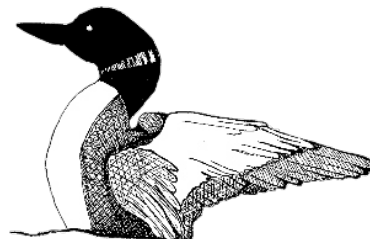
In 2018 Autumn addressed world leaders at the UN General Assembly on the issue of water protection. In 2017, she confronted Justin Trudeau with her beliefs.

Autumn lives in Wikwemikong First Nation in Northern Ontario.

Afternoon Speakers:

Dr. John Gunn, a fisheries biologist, who has studied the effects of acid rain, climate change, and a variety of other environmental issues, will speak on the changes to Sudbury's water quality.

Miranda Virtanen, the Executive Director of the Junction Creek Stewardship Committee, will look at urban waterway issues (plastic waste, stormwater runoff, etc.), and citizen stewardship.

Please book before September 27th to ensure availability.

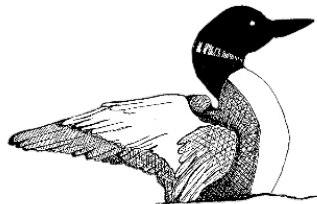

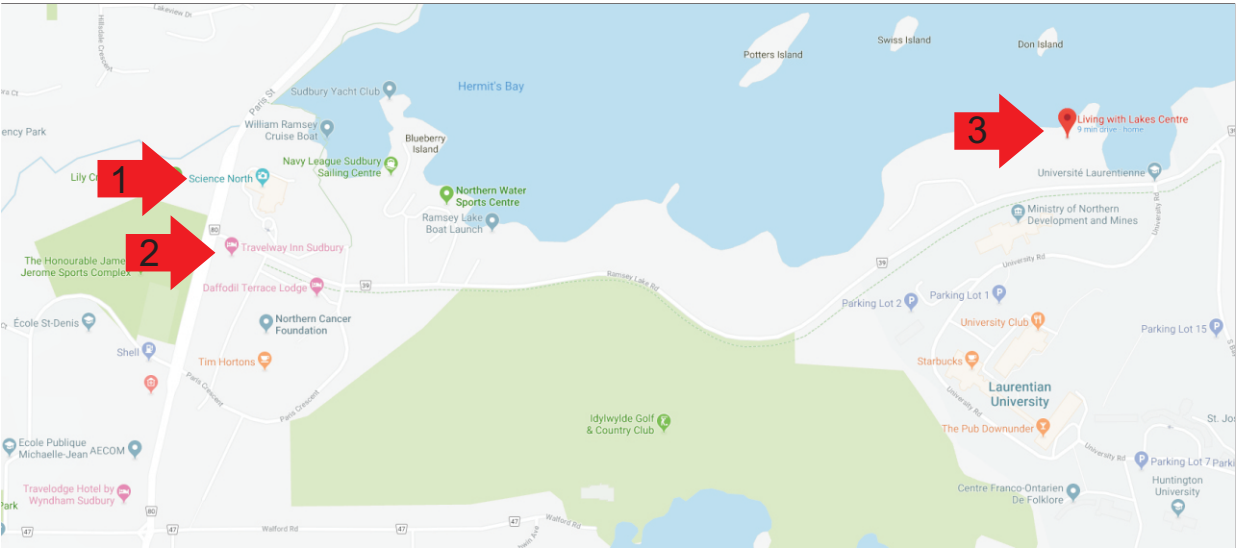

Directions to Living with Lakes Centre:

From Paris Street, turn onto Ramsey Lake Rd. at Science North. The Living with Lakes Centre is on the left, across from the entrance to Laurentian University.



Direction to the Friday Night Reception Venue from the Travelway Inn/Science North:

Turn left (south) on Paris St.

Turn left onto Regent St./Hwy 69

Turn left onto Loach's Rd at the stop lights just before Pizza Hut.
